Dear Mr. Mark Larsen,

I am pleased to let you know that we have seen great improvements in our shelter since installing Odorox equipment. Upper Respiratory Infection (URI) is easily transferred in a shelter setting and a common illness seen in shelter cats. Since installing the Odorox equipment we have noticed that cats brought to the shelter with symptoms clear up within several days. We employ the furnace-mounted machines to cycle through the shelter, but also use the smaller portable units in the rooms with symptomatic cats. With the machines, we have not had the shelter breakout with URI, which previously was quite common.

We have also noticed a significant improvement when treating our ringworm cats. For example, we placed a portable machine in a foster home that was working to treat 10 ringworm kittens and noticed the lesions began to immediately heal, where previously it would take a couple weeks and reinfection was common. Most recently, we had some kittens come in with ringworm, which was not detected for 4 or 5 days. They were housed in a room with a number of other cats, none of which subsequently contracted it. As it is an airborne spore we were very pleased with the efficacy of your Odorox hydroxyl generators to prevent the spread of ringworm in our shelter.

In short, we are very happy with the improvement in the health of our cats and the reduction of disease transfer since introducing the equipment.
